Prompt

Purpose

<u>Presentation Requirements</u>

- MUST address the following four components using separate slides:
 - Context of 19th century music
 - Composer biography
 - Analysis of selected piece
 - Listening of piece that exemplifies style of composer
- 5-10 minutes in length
- Trifold board, google slides, Lensoo, or Comic Strip It
- Visually stimulating
- Presenter elaborates on what the audience sees. Examples include:
 - Slides give bullet points, and presenter elaborates
 - Trifold board gives pictures and key dates, and presenter elaborates
 - NOT reading or memorizing verbatim the slide content

Your presentation will be graded based on a rubric including Required Content, Research, Mechanics, and Organization.
